But, finally, the more we engage ourselves in this project, the more we realise that what we do is vital for these kids. In return we receive so much energy from the children we meet.

Our NGO AVEC, having made itself a good reputation among the teachers in the neighbouring schools, currently faces a huge demand of support from a big number of schools. Since we would like to stick to our objectives and keep our budget as well as we possibly can, we actively search for help: from anywhere and of any kind, because so important is this task.
